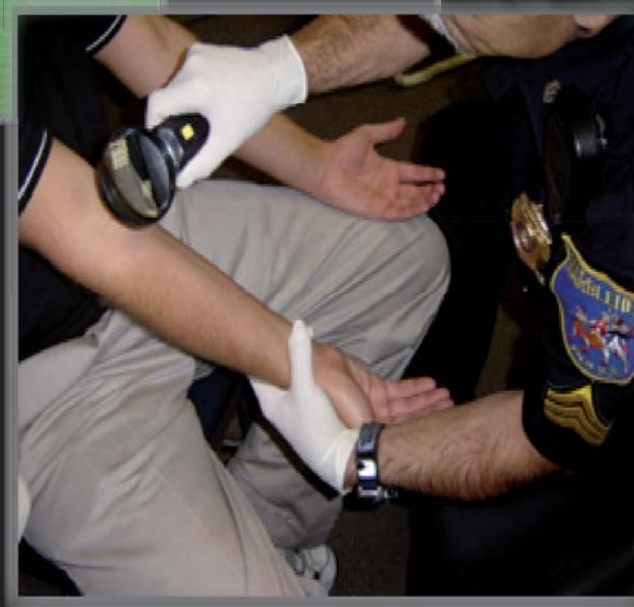

ANTHONY D. PALACIOS, COURSE INSTRUCTOR

Anthony Palacios is the former Standardized Field Sobriety Testing State Coordinator for the state of Georgia and a former Impaired Driving Instructor for the Georgia Police Academy. Anthony is an International Association Chiefs of Police DRE Instructor and a National Highway Traffic Safety Administration DUI/SFST Instructor. Anthony has trained over 3,000 Georgia, South Carolina and Tennessee law enforcement officers and prosecutors in the detection of drivers under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs. Anthony has instructed the DRE instructor course, DRE Pre-School, DRE 7 Day School and DRE Re-Certification course over 30 times to law enforcement officers, as well as the DUI/SFST practitioner course, DUI/SFST Instructor course, SFST Instructor Update course, SFST Refresher course and Drugs That Impair Driving course over 135 times to law enforcement officers and legal professionals. Additionally, Anthony has spoken at the national and state level on DRE/DUI related topics. After his law enforcement career, Anthony entered into the private sector and is now a nationwide DUI consultant for legal professionals.

Steve Oberman hails from Knoxville, Tennessee where he has been practicing law in the field of criminal defense, with an emphasis on DUI defense, since 1980. Steve has successfully represented over two thousand clients charged with DUI and/or vehicular homicide. He is the author of *DUI: The Crime & Consequences in Tennessee*, a Thomson-West Publishing Company text widely relied upon by judges and lawyers throughout Tennessee. Additionally, Steve is co-author with Lawrence Taylor of the Aspen Publisher's national treatise, *Drunk Driving Defense*, 6th edition. In 2006, Steve became the first lawyer certified as a DUI Defense Specialist by the Tennessee Commission on Continuing Legal Education and Specialization. Steve has been a member of the Board of Regents of the National College for DUI Defense since 1999 and has been chair or co-chair of the National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers DUI Committee since 1995. In his spare time, Steve serves as an adjunct professor at the University of Tennessee College of Law. He has enjoyed teaching his Trial Advocacy class since 1993 and has received prestigious awards for his faculty contributions. His other teaching engagements have included lecturing about trial skills and DUI defense topics at seminars in 17 different states as well as overseas in England.
